OBIA Blade Sign Grant Program

Overview

The Orangeville BIA (OBIA) recognizes the importance of effective signage to brick & mortar businesses and specifically, the effectiveness of blade (projecting) signage to attract pedestrians. The Downtown Orangeville Blade Sign Grant is intended to provide financial assistance to OBIA Members who add an approved blade (projecting) sign to their commercial facade.

Responsibilities

The OBIA will:

- Assist applicants with Blade Sign Grant application and related inquiries.
- Approve grant applications & distribute funds to approved applicants.

The Applicant is responsible for (but not limited to) the following:

- Applying for a sign permit
- Purchase of the blade sign
- Design of the sign face, etc.
- Pre-payment of any fees/costs as required by the Town or sign company

Coverage

The grant will cover up to a maximum of \$635 CAD for the following eligible expenses:

Eligible Expenses

✓ Purchase of Sign (sign face/sign frame/sign bracket)

✓ Installation of the sign

✓ Town of Orangeville Sign Permit Fee

Ineligible Expenses

X Graphic Design for the sign

X Taxes

X Insurance

Eligibility

To be eligible:

- The sign face must identify the nature of the business or what one might find inside, not just the business name (example: "Books & Games", "Bistro", "Art Supplies")
- The applicant must be authorized to apply on behalf of the business and/or property owner.
- The property owner must agree to the installation of the sign.
- The sign must be installed on a commercial property located within the boundaries of the OBIA.
- The sign must be approved by the Town of Orangeville though the Town's sign permit process, including Heritage Orangeville approval (if necessary).

- Applicant must provide the OBIA with a copy of a valid Town of Orangeville sign permit.
- Proof of purchase (i.e., copy of purchase, installation and/or permit fee invoices) must be provided.

Please note:

- The Town of Orangeville requires that the sign must be included as part of your commercial liability insurance policy.
- The Town of Orangeville no longer requires signs to be installed by a Town-licensed sign installer however, we highly recommend that the sign is installed by a professional.
- A Road Occupancy Permit may be required for the installation of your sign, so be sure to ask about this when you submit your Permit Application to the Town.

- Once your grant application has been submitted and approved, it could take 2-3 weeks before your cheque is ready.

Choosing A Sign Frame

Fast Track Option - Pre-approved Sign Frame:

Three sign frame designs have been pre-approved by Heritage Orangeville and the Town of Orangeville. Choosing one of these pre-approved frame options (shown below) will allow for a quicker and cheaper Orangeville Sign Permit process. These pre-approved sign frame designs can be purchased from the following companies:

A local sign company may also be able to make you one of the pre-approved signs. See the Grant FAQ's for a list of local sign companies.

Standard Option – Custom or Other Sign Frame:

Members can opt for a custom or alternative stock frame design and proceed through the standard Town of Orangeville Sign Permit process.

Fast-Track

- These 3 pre-approved designs qualify for a reduced sign permit fee of \$50 (normally \$100);
- These 3 pre-approved designs meet all Town of Orangeville sign bylaw requirements.
- A Town of Orangeville Sign Permit is required.

Standard

- All signs must meet the requirements of the Town of Orangeville's sign bylaw and be approved by Heritage Orangeville.
- Town of Orangeville Blade Sign Permit fee starts at \$100.
- A Town of Orangeville Sign Permit is required.

Blade Sign Grant Application Process:

1. Consult with the BIA review eligibility requirements.					
2. Consult with a sign company, choose your sign frame and design the sign face.					
3. Share your design with the BIA to ensure that the sign design qualifies for the grant.					
4. Apply for a Town of Orangeville sign permit.					
5. Upon Town approval for the permit, share any changes to the original design with the BIA.					
6. Finalize your design & sign purchase with the sign company.

7. Install your sign.

8. Submit your blade sign grant application & eligible invoices to the BIA.

9. Receive your Grant.					

We strongly recommend contacting us in advance of your blade sign purchase to review the grant requirements.

- Sign Installation invoice (if claiming reimbursement)
- Copy of the approved Town of Orangeville Sign Permit
- Image or content of the sign face

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Does the blade sign grant cover design of the sign?

No. Graphic design/artwork for sign is not covered by this grant program.

2. Is a Blade Sign the same as a Projecting Sign?

Yes. Blade signs are also called projecting signs or perpendicular signs. The Town of Orangeville calls them "Projecting Signs" so be sure to check the "Projecting Sign "sections of the Town of Orangeville's Sign By-law under the proper zone type for your business address.

3. Do I need a sign permit?

Yes. The Town of Orangeville requires a permit for blade (projecting) signs under the Sign By-Law. If your business is located in the Heritage District (check map on page 37 of the Sign By-Law), more rules apply to you (pages 21-25 of the Sign By-Law).

4. Where can I find the Town of Orangeville Sign Permit Application?

5. Do I need a Road Occupancy Permit?

Maybe. Depending on where your business is located, you may need a Road Occupancy Permit for the installation of the sign. A permit is required

if the sign installer installs the sign from the public sidewalk versus private property.

6. I would like to use my business name or my logo for the sign, is this OK? Maybe. To qualify for the grant, the sign must clearly indicate what your business sells/offers. Blade signs are used to communicate what is inside the business so visitors can easily identify what you sell. For this reason, we recommend using an easy-to-read font that identifies your main business focus. You can still include your business name or logo, but it should be smaller or secondary to what you sell.

• Example: "Café & Smoothies" instead of just "EUPHORIA"

• Example: "Vintage Home & Garden" instead of just "blumen"

• Example: "Café & Patisserie" instead of just "Le Finis"

- 7. Can I choose to go with a different company and/or design for my frame, outside of the options listed in the grant application documents?
 Yes! Applicants can go with another company to manufacture one of the pre-approved designs or you can go with a different sign design.
 - If choosing one of the pre-approved designs, the sign frames must adhere to the engineering specifications included in the grant application in order to qualify for the Fast-Track process because these pre-approved designs have already undergone the frame approval process with the Town to speed up your application.
 - All other designs need to be approved by Heritage Orangeville and The Town of Orangeville.
- 8. I'd like to purchase my sign from a local business. Are there any local sign companies that can make my blade sign or install my sign for me?

9. Will the BIA pay the Town (for my permit fee) and the sign company (for my sign and/or my sign installation) directly?

No. The BIA will issue you a cheque for up to \$635 upon approval of your application. It could take 2-3 weeks before you receive your cheque.

10. Why are the frame price estimates in USD?

Quoted prices are for stock items from the Sign Bracket Store website.

Similar designs can be custom ordered from Red Iron Designs or local sign companies, but you will need to ask those companies for prices.
